We started with the licence TOS/395, TOS/491A, and TOS/482A.

We have been producing oysters since.

In the same time we did make an application for new licences: TOS/517A and B.

TOS/482B

TOS/565A

This year 2018, we have got our renewal licence where we already work oysters for years.

and like we did suppose the higher licences on the beach.

TOS/517A/B TOS/482B and TOS/595A were refused

due to the binds and the full time expose out of water.

Unfortunately, we do not understand why TOS/565A,

which is located on the right side of our actual TOS/482A

and just above TOS/491A in a deep water side, was

refused.

We do understand about the binds on the beach up high.

We don't wish to go there and the beach side, before

TOS/395 and TOS/482A, but would to take the potential

for the oysters in that half deep water side on
Tos/545A.


I do believe by my experience, that with the Bags, and

Tos/395 Tos/488A Tos/491A.

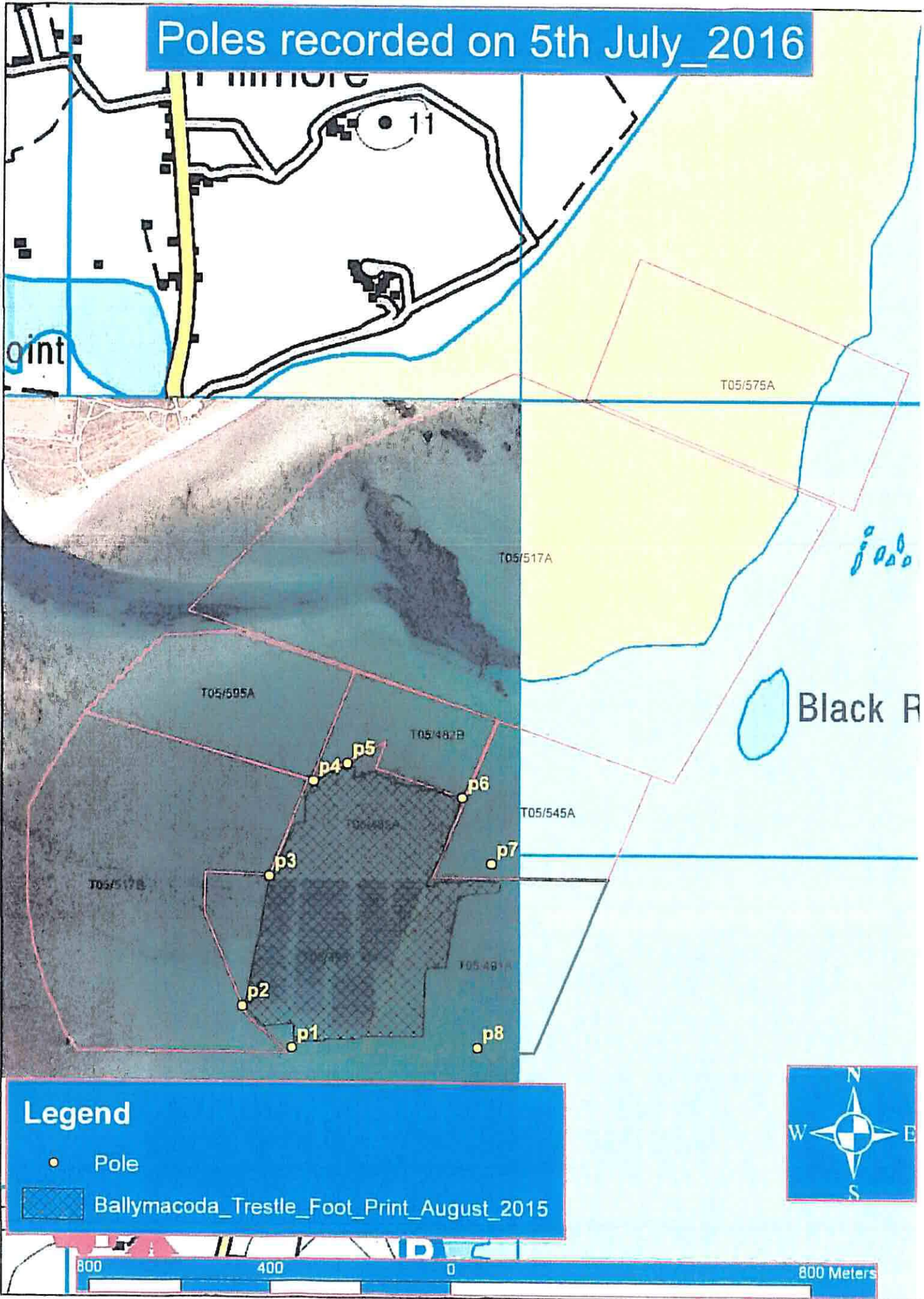
