

Re: Appeal relating to Sites Ref. T03/038A and T03/095A

Dear Mr. Hurley

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your Notice of Appeal, and the accompanying fee of €150.00, in respect of the above decisions which was received in this office by registered post on 8 February 2023.

An appeal must relate to one application for an aquaculture licence and subsequent decision of the Minister on that application. In the case of the above two sites, two separate licence applications were submitted and the Minister issued two decisions.

Section 41(1)(f) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997 provides that a notice of appeal shall be accompanied by such fee, if any, as may be payable in respect of such an appeal in accordance with regulations under <u>section 63</u>.

Your appeal form references the two sites but was accompanied by only one fee. As the latest date for receipt of valid appeals has expired, please indicate which of the above sites you wish to appeal.

It should be noted that both licence applications relating to these two sites have been appealed by another party. You will have the option to submit observations as part of the standard observation period on the site which is not the subject of your own appeal.
