

## INTRODUCTION BY CHAIRPERSON

I am pleased to present the Annual Report of the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board (ALAB) for the year **2023**. In addition to fulfilling its primary function of reporting to the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine ('the Minister') on the activities of the Board, we hope that the Report will provide useful information to all involved in the appeals process and to the wider aquaculture industry.

The Board continued to operate in an efficient manner throughout the year, fulfilling its core function to provide an independent appeal authority to adjudicate on decisions of the Minister on aquaculture licence applications. While only seven (7) appeals were received in 2023, thirty-seven (37) appeals were on hand at the start of the year. By the end of the year there were forty-four (44) appeals on hand. The appeals on hand are complex and in addition the Board dealt with a significant judicial review of an earlier determination. The hearing of that case took place over three weeks in April/May 2023 and preparation for, and attendance at, the hearing of the review absorbed a significant amount of time and resources. This Report contains detailed information on, and analysis of, all appeals on hand with the Board by the end of 2023.

The Board notes that the Report of the Independent Aquaculture Licencing Review Group, May 2017, made a number of recommendations which were designed to both improve the quality and clarity of applications and to facilitate a timely decision-making process. In this context, the Board has completed a number of internal processes, including the redesign and updating of the ALAB website to make information concerning the Board and appeals more accessible and its processes more transparent. Further enhancements of the website are being developed including enabling the website to facilitate the online submission of appeals and payment of appeal fees.

I would like to express appreciation to the officials from the Department of Agriculture Food and the Marine and to all other State Bodies with which ALAB interacts for their support during the year. I would also like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the contributions of all ALAB Board members, ALAB staff and all external service providers, who were instrumental in supporting ALAB in delivering its statutory responsibilities during 2023. As an organisation, ALAB continues to adapt while also striving to maintain its good performance. I would particularly like to acknowledge the real commitment of the ALAB Board members to the values of independence, integrity, professionalism, and fairness. It has been a great pleasure to work with you during 2023 and indeed throughout.

Finally, after 10 years as serving as the Chairperson of the Board, I will be stepping down at the end of March 2024. During my tenure with the Board, I have worked with fourteen Board Members and four Secretaries, all of whom, in different ways, provided insight, guidance and knowledge of the aquaculture industry in Ireland and the licencing process. The Board has faced many hurdles over my time, a particular challenge being seeking to ensure that sufficient and appropriate resources are available to the Board to fulfil its obligations. I believe I leave the Board in good stead, and I would like to take this opportunity to thank all colleagues with whom I have worked on the ALAB Board over those ten years, as well as the ALAB Secretariat and the Department for the support over my two terms in office.

## ESTABLISHMENT OF BOARD

The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board was established on 17th June 1998 under Section 22 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997 (as amended). All Board members are engaged on a part-time basis.

## FUNCTION

The Board operates under the aegis of the Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine.

The function of the Board is to provide an independent authority for the determination of appeals against decisions of the relevant Minister on aquaculture licence applications. A person aggrieved by a decision of the Minister on an aquaculture licence application, or by the revocation or amendment of an aquaculture licence, may make an appeal within one month of publication (in the case of a decision) or notification (in the case of revocation/amendment).

## STATUS

The Board is an independent body with its own funding provided for by the Oireachtas under Section 36 of the 1997 Act.

## COMPOSITION OF BOARD

Section 23(2) of the 1997 Act provides that the Chairperson of the Board shall be appointed by the Government.

In accordance with Section 23(3) of the 1997 Act, the Minister for Agriculture, Food, and the Marine ("the Minister") may make regulations prescribing not less than two organisations to nominate members of the Board. Those organisations should, in the Minister's opinion, be representative of the following groupings:

- a) organisations concerned with the promotion of the development of aquaculture or representative of persons carrying on the business of developing aquaculture.
- b) organisations concerned with the conservation, development, and protection of wild fisheries.
- c) organisations representative of persons whose professions or occupations relate to physical planning and development.
- d) organisations representative of persons concerned with the protection and preservation of the environment and amenities.
- e) organisations representative of persons concerned with the promotion of general economic development and
- f) organisations representative of persons concerned with the promotion of community development.

## MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD

As provided for under Section 23 of the 1997 Act, the Board consists of a Chairman and six other members.

The Chair, Ms. Imelda Reynolds, was re-appointed by the Government in accordance with Section 23(2) of the 1997 Act, for a second term of 5 years from 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2024.

Mr. Michael Mulloy was appointed to the Board on the 6 June 2018 for a period of five years up to 5 June 2023. He was reappointed to the Board for a period of five years up to 19 June 2028.

Mr. Micheál Ó Cinnéide was appointed to the Board on 17 July 2019 for a period of five years up to 16 July 2024. He was appointed Deputy Chair on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

Mr. John Evans was appointed to the Board on 17 July 2019 for a period of five years up to 16 July 2024.

Mr. Bill Sweeney was appointed to the Board on 17 July 2019 for a period of five years up to 16 July 2024.

Ms Maura Canning was appointed to the Board on 17 November 2023 for a period of five years up to 16 November 2028.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

The 1997 Act details the main responsibilities and powers of the Board, which are summarised as follows:

Under Section 40(4) of the 1997 Act, on receipt of an appeal by the Board and provided it is not withdrawn, the Board can determine the appeal by:

- a) confirming the decision or action of the Minister.
- b) determining the application for the licence as if the application had been made to the Board in the first instance; or
- c) in relation to the revocation or amendment of a licence, substituting its decision on the matter for that of the Minister.

Under Sections 43 and 44 of the 1997 Act, the Board must send a copy of the notice of appeal to the Minister and to each other party to the appeal.

Under Section 46 of the 1997 Act, the Board can request submissions or observations from parties or other persons who have already made submissions or observations to the Board in relation to an appeal, if, in the opinion of the Board and in the circumstances, it is in the interests of justice to do so.

Under Section 47 of the 1997 Act, the Board can request documents, particulars, or other information it considers necessary for the purpose of enabling it to determine an appeal.

Under Section 49 of the 1997 Act, the Board has the absolute discretion to hold an oral hearing of an appeal.

Under Section 56 of the 1997 Act, the Board is required to ensure that appeals are dealt with and determined expeditiously and that all steps are taken to avoid unnecessary delay.

## CONSULTANTS AND ADVISORS

Under Section 35 of the 1997 Act, the Board may engage such consultants or advisors as it considers necessary for the performance of its functions. Fees due to consultants and advisors are paid by the Board out of monies made available by the Oireachtas. The Board has hired and will continue to hire consultant Technical Advisers when necessary. The Board also engages other advisors as required to support its work. A list of the persons engaged by the Board during the year in review is included in Appendix 1.


## SECRETARIAT

Under Section 32 of the 1997 Act, an officer of the Minister who is an established civil servant and who is seconded to the Board for that purpose, either on a whole-time or part-time basis, shall act as Secretary to the Board. The full time Secretary to the Board is Margaret Carton.

## SECTION 3: OTHER DEVELOPMENTS

## LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

In accordance with Section 73 of the 1997 Act, a person or body can apply for judicial review of a determination of the Board by way of an application for judicial review, provided it is made within the period of three months commencing on the date on which the determination was made.

During 2019, Lough Swilly Wild Oyster Society Limited issued proceedings against the Minister and against the Board under Record No: 277/2019JR, seeking certain reliefs and orders against both the Minister and the Board. The Board has filed a Statement of Opposition to the Application and a decision is awaited.

During 2019 Silver King Seafoods Limited made an application to the High Court seeking leave to apply for judicial review to challenge the determination of the Minister that it had breached a condition of Aquaculture Licence register reference T06/202 and discontinuing the company's statutory entitlement to continue aquaculture operations for the culture of salmon in cages at a site east of Deenish Island in a Ballinskelligs Bay, Co. Kerry, pursuant to Section 19 a (4) of the 1997 Act. The Court granted Silver King Seafoods the leave sought which included an Order granting a stay on ALAB considering and determining their appeal to ALAB pending the final determination of the proceedings. The stay was subsequently lifted, and the matter is adjourned generally pending ALAB's determination of Appeal AP1/2019.

In 2020 An Taisce initiated judicial review proceedings to challenge the decision of the Board to refuse to accept An Taisce's appeal of the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine to grant licences for the bottom cultivation of mussels in Wexford Harbour. The Board has filed a Statement of Opposition to the Application and a decision is awaited. This Judicial Review is set for a two day hearing in January 2024.

During 2021 Inland Fisheries Ireland, Peter Sweetman and others, and Salmon Watch Ireland CLG sought leave to apply for judicial review to challenge the determination of the Board in Appeals AP2/1-14/2015, Shot Head Co Cork. These cases were admitted to the Commercial Court and a Hearing took place in April/May 2023. As of time of writing, a judgement is awaited.

In early 2023 Kush Seafarms Limited initiated judicial review proceedings to challenge the decision of the Board to refuse to grant aquaculture licences for two sites on the foreshore of Kilmakilloge Harbour, Co. Kerry. The Board has filed a Statement of Opposition and a hearing date is awaited.

## PLANNING/ENVIRONMENTAL LAW DEVELOPMENTS

Increasingly complex environmental policy and legislation, as well as an evolving body of case law is having a significant influence on how the Board is dealing with appeals which come before it. The Board continues to review and update its procedures for the consideration and determination of appeals to take account of all relevant legislation and emerging case law.

## RESOURCES

The board places great value and reliance on the professional expertise, integrity, dedication, and public service ethos of its staff. It recognises their commitment and dedication to the Board's goal of providing its stakeholders with a high quality and efficient service. The Secretariat staff are operating on a blended working model. The Board has established a pattern of meeting in person four times each year while continuing to avail of the efficiencies associated with online meetings. The retention of an internal Technical Advisor has, over the last three years, allowed for some 107 determinations to be made. In addition, having a full complement of Board Members, with representatives from various classes of organisations, is important when making determinations. Therefore, the upcoming vacancies that are due to arise, including the Chair should be filled as a matter of urgency to avoid a negative impact on making determinations.

## WEBSITE

ALAB maintains an active website at [www.alab.ie](http://www.alab.ie). The website has been redesigned to simplify navigation and make information more accessible. Further enhancements will take place in 2024. In due course it is intended that the website will facilitate the online submission of appeals and associated fees.

## SECTION 4: CORPORATE GOVERNANCE

Corporate Governance in ALAB is designed to follow the requirements of the 2016 Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies (the Code) to the extent appropriate, given the small size of the body. ALAB is committed to reviewing its governance policies and procedures on an on-going basis to ensure continued compliance with best practice in this area.

In this context, as required by the Code, the following are confirmed:

1. No commercially significant developments affected ALAB in the period 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2023, nor is the Board aware of any major issues likely to arise in the short to medium term.
2. There are no off-balance sheet financial transactions that are not disclosed in the annual report and financial statements of ALAB.
3. All appropriate procedures for financial reporting, internal audit, travel, procurement, and asset disposals are being carried out.
4. Codes of Conduct for the Board and employees have been put in place and adhered to.
5. As all staff of ALAB are seconded to it by the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine, and Government policy on the pay of CEOs and all State body employees is being complied with.
6. Government guidelines on the payment of Board members' fees are being complied with.
7. No significant post balance sheet events have occurred.
8. The appropriate requirements of the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform Public Spending Code are being complied with.
9. Procedures are in place for the making of protected disclosures in accordance with section 21(1) of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014 and the annual report required under section 22(1) of the Act has been published.

10. Government travel policy requirements are being complied with in all respects.
11. ALAB has complied with its obligations under tax law.
12. There are no legal disputes involving other State bodies with the exception of the following four judicial review proceedings being taken:
  - Inland Fisheries Ireland against the Board's determination in Appeals AP2/1-14/2015, Shot Head Co. Cork. A judgement is awaited in that matter.
  - An Taisce against the Board's decision not to accept one appeal fee to be applied to numerous determinations made by the Minister in Wexford Harbour. The hearing is due to take place in January 2024.
  - Kush Seafarms Ltd challenging the decision of ALAB to refuse an aquaculture licence. No hearing date has yet been assigned to this case.
  - Lough Swilly Wild Oyster Society Limited issued proceedings against the Minister and against the Board, seeking certain reliefs and orders against both the Minister and the Board. The Board has filed a Statement of Opposition to the Application and a decision is awaited.
13. The Code has been adopted and ALAB is in compliance with the Code to the extent appropriate given the size and scale of the Board; and
14. ALAB does not have any subsidiaries.

## IRISH LANGUAGE COMMITMENT

ALAB is committed to implementing the relevant parts of the Official Languages Act 2003 and the Official Languages (Amendment) Act 2021 which came into force in October 2022. The latter requires all public bodies to undertake at least 20% of their annual advertising in Irish and 5% of their advertising in Irish language media. ALAB will continue to review its advertising procedures to ensure that it meets these targets.

## CODE OF ETHICS AND BUSINESS CONDUCT

The Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies requires a written code of conduct for Board members and employees. A Code of Ethics and Business Conduct is in place for all the members of the Board and is posted on the website at [www.alab.ie](http://www.alab.ie).

In addition, members and certain staff are subject to the requirements of the Ethics in Public Office Acts, 1995 and 2001, and yearly statements of registrable interests are made under the Acts.

Board members and certain staff are also required to make declarations/disclosures of interests in accordance with Section 33 of the 1997 Act.

## CONSULTATIONS WITH OTHER BODIES

The Board keeps itself informed of the policies of certain bodies whose functions have a bearing on its work. These include other Government Departments and State Agencies.

## PUBLIC SECTOR EQUALITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS DUTY

Section 42 of the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission Act 2014 imposes a statutory obligation on public bodies in performing their functions to have regard to the need to:

1. Eliminate discrimination.
2. Promote equality of opportunity and treatment for staff and persons to whom it provides services and
3. Protect the human rights of staff and service users.

The Board endeavours to facilitate access to our services for all members of the public in as far as it is reasonable and practicable.

## GENDER BALANCE IN THE BOARD MEMBERSHIP

Throughout 2023 the Board consisted of two female members (33%) and 4 male (67%) members. The Board therefore does not meet the Government target of a minimum of 40% representation of each gender in the membership of State Boards. The appointment of one female board member towards the end of the year provided an opportunity to address this imbalance.

ALAB has no role in relation to the Board appointments other than indicating to the Minister that ALAB does not fulfil the gender balance target. In accordance with the Act, Board members are appointed by the Minister after seeking nominations from the specified organisations.

## BOARD PERFORMANCE REVIEW

Monitoring of effective corporate governance by the Board includes continuous review of the internal structure of the State body to ensure that there are clear lines of accountability for management throughout the organisation.

## DIVERSITY

The Board recognises the value of differences in its members (e.g., personality, learning styles, and life experiences) and group/social differences (e.g., ethnicity, social class, gender, sexual orientation, disability, membership of the Traveller community, family status, cultural, political, religious, or other affiliations) to improve the quality of work and decision making on the Board.

## DATA PROTECTION AND GDPR

Data Protection legislation is in place to protect the natural person with regard to the processing of personal data.

## PROMPT PAYMENTS

ALAB comes within the scope of the Prompt Payment of Accounts Act 1997, as amended by the European Communities (Late Payment in Commercial Transactions) Regulations 2002.

It is ALAB's policy to comply with the relevant provisions of the Act and, in particular, to ensure that all invoices are paid promptly. Prompt Payment Returns are posted on the website at [www.alab.ie](http://www.alab.ie).

## GREEN GOVERNMENT INITIATIVE

Following the Government's introduction of the Green Government Initiative to facilitate Departments and public bodies to lead the way in reducing the use of single use plastics and to improve and increase recycling, ALAB produced 'Our Environmental Sustainability Policy'.

This policy aims to reduce the impact of ALAB's operations on the environment, through its 'Green Agenda' initiative. No single-use plastics are in use and glassware is in use throughout the office. The Board had previously adopted the use of a paperless data management system which effectively reduces costs by eliminating the use of large amounts of paper, ink, and electricity.

The introduction of online Board meetings and their continued use has significantly reduced the amount of travel undertaken as part of the business of the Board.

## COMPLIANCE WITH RELEVANT CIRCULARS

Circular 01/2020 issued by the Department of Public Expenditure, National Development Plan Delivery and Reform in January 2020, relates to the procedures for offsetting greenhouse gas emissions associated with official air travel.

In line with the provisions of that circular, all Government Departments, Offices, and agencies are, with effect from 1 January 2020, required to record, monitor, and value the greenhouse gas emissions associated with official air travel usage and, no later than 28 February each year, make a payment to the Fund Manager of the statutory Climate Action Fund related to these emissions for the preceding year.

ALAB did not undertake any official air travel in 2023 or any of the three preceding years from 2020 to 2022.



Where ALAB has the view more documents/ particulars/information is necessary to enable it to determine an appeal it shall serve notice on the party or person, within a period specified in the notice (being not less than **30 days** beginning on the date of service of the notice, S.47

Where the Board is of the opinion that it is appropriate in the interests of justice to request a party or other person who has made submissions or observations to the Board in relation to the appeal to make submissions or observations in relation to any matter which has arisen in relation to the appeal it may, in its discretion, requesting the party or person, within a period specified in the notice being not less than **30 days** beginning on the date of service of the notice, to submit to the Board submissions or observations in relation to the matter, S. 46

The Technical Advisor will assess the requirement for environmental reports (EIA/AA) and prepares a technical report on the appeal for the consideration of the Board.

If ALAB in determining the appeal is considering matters other than those raised by the parties to the appeal it must notify all parties and give between 14 and 28 days for them to make submissions/observations, S. 50

S 56(2)(a) requires that the Board to determine an Appeal within a period of four months beginning on the date of receipt by the Board of the Notice of Appeal. If the Board cannot determine the appeal within the period required it can be extended by notice in writing served on the parties to the appeal and all persons who made submissions or observations to the Board, S. 56(3)

An appeal is determined in accordance with S.61. Determination either 40(4)(a), (b)

A person may question the validity of this decision by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) in accordance with section 73 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997 (No. 23).

#### Governance

The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board was established on 17 June 1998 under Section 22 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997. The function of the Board is to provide an independent authority for the determination of appeals against decisions of the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine on aquaculture licence applications.

#### Board Responsibilities

The work and responsibilities of the Board are set out in Sections 40 to 60 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997. Standing items considered by the Board include:

- Declaration of interests
- Reports from committees
- Financial reports/management accounts, and
- Appeals in progress

Section 37 (1) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997 requires the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board to keep, in such form as may be approved by the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine with consent of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, all proper and usual accounts of money received and expended by it.

In preparation of those statements the Board is required to:

- Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently,
- Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent,
- State whether the financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards,
- Prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis.

The Board is responsible for keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Board and which enable it to ensure that the financial statements comply with Section 37 (1) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997. The Board is also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Board and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

The Board considers that the financial statements of Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board give a true and fair view of the financial performance and the financial position of the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board at 31 December 2023.

### Statement of Compliance

The Board has adopted the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies (2016) ("the Code") and has put procedures in place to ensure compliance with the Code. Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board was in full compliance with those provisions of the Code which apply it save for the following:

- The provisions of the Code concerning appointment, number, grading and conditions of all staff, including remuneration and superannuation do not apply to ALAB as all its staff are seconded from the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine ("DAFM").
- Given the size and scale of ALAB and the fact it is constituted solely to determine appeals pursuant to the Act, the Board is of the view that a formal strategic plan is not required. ALAB has agreed an Oversight and Performance Delivery Agreement 2021 - 2023 and this is currently in the process of being executed by both parties. This agreement has incorporated matters which might ordinarily be comprised in a strategic plan.
- ALAB does not have a Chief Risk Officer. Given the size and scale of ALAB's operation the Board has formed the view that risk can be managed between the Secretary, the Audit and Risk Committee and the Board itself.
- ALAB has contracted with an internal auditor to carry out this function. The Board does engage external expertise periodically where appropriate and in particular to undertake an annual review of internal controls.
- ALAB does not have a formal Corporate Procedure Plan. Given the size and scale of ALAB the Board has formed the view that such a plan is not required.
- ALAB does not have a Customer Charter. Given the nature of ALAB, the Board has formed the view that such a Charter is not appropriate.

### Statement on Internal Control

#### Scope of Responsibility

On behalf of Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board, we acknowledge our responsibility for ensuring that an effective system of Internal Control is maintained and operated in the organisation. The register is reviewed and updated by the ARC on a quarterly basis. The outcome of these assessments is used to plan and allocate resources to ensure risks are managed to an acceptable level.

The risk register details the controls and actions needed to mitigate risks and responsibility for operation of controls assigned to specific staff. We confirm that a control environment containing the following elements is in place:

- Procedures for all key business processes have been documented,
- Financial responsibilities have been assigned at management level with corresponding accountability,
- There is an appropriate budgeting system with an annual budget which is kept under review by senior management, and by the Board,
- There are systems aimed at ensuring the security of the information and communication technology systems, and
- There are systems in place to safeguard the assets

### Review of Effectiveness



### Responsibilities of Board members

As detailed in the governance statement and Board members' report, the Board members are responsible for

- the preparation of annual financial statements in the form prescribed under section 37 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997
- ensuring that the financial statements give a true and fair view in accordance with FRS102
- ensuring the regularity of transactions
- assessing whether the use of the going concern basis of accounting is appropriate, and
- such internal control as they determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### Responsibilities of the Comptroller and Auditor General

I am required under section 37 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997 to audit the financial statements of the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board and to report thereon to the Houses of the Oireachtas.

My objective in carrying out the audit is to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement due to fraud or error. If, based on the work I have performed, I conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information, I am required to report that fact.

### Reporting on other matters

My audit is conducted by reference to the special considerations which attach to State bodies in relation to their management and operation. I report if I identify material matters relating to the manner in which public business has been conducted.

I seek to obtain evidence about the regularity of financial transactions in the course of audit. I report if I identify any material instance where public money has not been applied for the purposes intended or where transactions did not conform to the authorities governing them.







### Notes to the Financial Statements

#### ACCOUNTING POLICIES

##### 1.a) GENERAL INFORMATION

The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board was established on 17 June 1998 under Section 22 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997 with a head office at Kilminchy Court, Dublin Road, Portlaoise, Co. Laois. The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Boards' primary objective is to deal with appeals against decisions of the Minister relating to aquaculture licences.

##### b) Statement of Compliance

The financial statements of Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board for the year ended 31st December 2023 have been prepared in accordance with FRS 102, the financial reporting standard applicable in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland issued by the Financial Reporting Council (FRC).

##### c) Basis of Preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, except for certain assets and liabilities that are measured at fair values as explained in the accounting policies below. The financial statements are in the form approved by the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine with the concurrence of the Minister for Finance under Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997. The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board financial statements.

##### d) Revenue

Appeal income and other income are recognised on an accruals basis. Oireachtas Grants are recognised on a cash receipts basis.

##### e) Employee Benefits

Short-term benefits such as holiday pay are recognised as an expense in the year, and benefits that are accrued at year-end are included in the Payables figure in the Statement of Financial Position

##### Employees and Superannuation

The Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board has 6 members of staff who are on secondment from the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine consisting of the secretary and three assistants, a technical advisor and an Assistant Principal. They are members of the civil service superannuation scheme. Accordingly, the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board has no liability in respect of superannuation.

Tá áthas orm Tuarascáil Bhliantúil an Bhoird Achomhairc um Cheadúnais Dobharshaothraithe (ALAB) don bhliain **2023** a thíolacadh. I dteannta a phríomhfheidhm a chomhlíonadh maidir le tuairisciú don Aire Talmhaíochta, Bia agus Mara ('an tAire') ar ghníomhaíochtaí an Bhoird, Táthar ag súil go gcuirfidh an Tuarascáil eolas úsáideach ar fáil do gach duine a bhfuil baint acu leis an bpróiseas achomharc agus don tionscal do bharshaothraithe i gcoitinne.

Tharla éisteacht an cháis sin i gcaitheamh trí seachtaine i mí Aibreáin/Bealtaine 2023 agus bhí méid suntasach ama agus acmhainní i gceist le hullmhúchán d'éisteacht an athbhreithnithe agus freastal uirthi. Sa Tuarascáil seo tá faisnéis mhionsonraithe maidir leis na hachomhairc go léir a bhí idir lámha ag an mBord faoi dheireadh 2023 agus anailís déanta orthu.

Tugann an Bord dá aire go ndearnadh roinnt moltaí i dTuarascáil an Ghrúpa Athbhreithnithe um Cheadúnú Dobharshaothraithe Neamhspleách, Bealtaine 2017, a bhí deartha chun cáilíocht agus soiléireacht iarratas a fheabhsú agus chun próiseas cinnteoireachta tráthúil a éascú. Ba mhaith liom freisin mo bhuíochas a ghabháil leis na hoifigigh ón Roinn Talmhaíochta, Bia agus Mara agus leis na Comhlachtaí Stáit eile go léir a mbíonn ALAB ag idirghníomhú leo as a dtacaíocht i rith na bliana. Ba mhaith liom an deis seo a thapú freisin chun aitheantas a thabhairt don rannchuidiú a rinne comhaltaí Boird uile ALAB, foireann ALAB agus gach soláthróir seirbhíse seachtrach, a bhí lánach i dtaca le tacaíocht a thabhairt do ALAB a fhreagrachtaí reachtúla a chomhlíonadh le linn 2023. Mar eagraíocht, leanann ALAB de bheith ag dul in oiriúint agus a dhícheall á dhéanamh aige a dhea-fheidhmíocht a chaomhnú. Ba mhaith liom aitheantas ar leith a thabhairt d'fhíor-thiomantas chomhaltaí Bhord ALAB do luachanna neamhspleáchais, ionracais, gairmiúlachta agus cothroime. Ba mhór an pléisiúr dom a bheith ag obair libh le linn 2023 agus go deimhin i rith mo thréimhse.
