Dear Antoinette,

I refer to your correspondence of 13 January 2022 in relation to matters before the Aquaculture Licence Appeals Board as regards the site referenced above.

I consider that this Department has provided information to ALAB as required, to enable its deliberations within its own remit to be carried out. You might note the clarifications sought in my letter of 18 November 2021 which have not yet been responded to. The relevance of any consideration of the extent and frequency of the use of long-established rights under Oyster Orders is not readily apparent in the context of an appeal of a refusal to grant an aquaculture licence. There is no information that the existence or ongoing exercise of these rights was a consideration in the Minister's (AFM) decision to refuse the original application to ground an appeal to ALAB on these specific issue. I would be grateful to receive this information.

For the avoidance of doubt, I can confirm that the rights exist, are, I understand, availed of currently and it is, in this Departments view, not appropriate that other activity, including aquaculture activity, over these areas is permitted. The only manner in which these rights can be altered is via a decision of the Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications.

DECC is willing to discuss the issues with ALAB to resolve matters.
