Appeal against the decision of the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine to grant Aquaculture Licence to Wild Atlantic Sea Products Ltd., South Allihies, Allihies, Beara, Co Cork, Site Ref T5/591 for the cultivation of seaweeds using a longline grid system on a site on the foreshore adjacent to Bank Harbour, Castletownbere, Bantry Bay, Co. Cork ("the Appeal")

## **Dear Sirs**

I refer to the Appeal, to the Board's Notice dated 18<sup>th</sup> February 2020 ("the Notice") issued pursuant to Section 47(1) (a) of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act, 1997, as amended, ("the Act"), and to your recent response to that Notice enclosing an email dated 16 March 2020 and revised site maps and co-ordinates.

It appears from your response that all the boundaries of the proposed Site have been adjusted. However the Board required the revised Site, as licenced by the Minister, to remain as per the Minister's Licence, save and except for a revised <u>easterly boundary</u> to the said Site such that no part of Site T5/591 is within 120m distance of the Site T05/444D, being the site adjacent to Site T5/591, the subject to of the Appeal. The Board hereby requires that you prepare and submit to the Board:

- a revised Site plan; and
- revised co-ordinates

for the proposed Licence Site T5/591, incorporating such revised easterly boundary only.

For the avoidance of doubt, following completion of the revised Site plan and co-ordinates, the Board also requires the revised area of the Site so that same may be specified in Schedule 1 to the Aquaculture Licence, as well as the co-ordinates for the Site based on the Irish National Grid Co-ordinate System.

Please also note that a person who refuses or fails to comply with a requirement under section 47 (1)(a) shall be guilty of an offence.
