**FISHERIES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1997 (NO.23)
NOTICE OF MINISTERIAL DECISION TO REFUSE TO GRANT AN
AQUACULTURE LICENCE AND FORESHORE LICENCE.**

Dear Secretary,

I would like to inform you that the Minister For Agriculture, Food and the Marine has refused your application for Aquaculture Licences and Foreshore Licences, for the cultivation of oysters using bags and trestles on sites nos. T03/86A, B & C (see attached information note). I enclose a copy of the public notice of the decision which **the Department** has arranged to have published in "Wexford People".

Any person aggrieved by the decision may, in accordance with Section 41 of the Fisheries (Amendment) Act 1997, appeal against it in writing to the Aquaculture Licences Appeals Board. This appeal must be lodged within one month beginning on the date of the publication of the decision.

NATURE OF DECISION: Refusal of Licence.

DATE OF DECISION: 4th July 2018

REASON FOR REFUSAL:

The findings of the Appropriate Assessment of aquaculture in the Bannow Bay Natura sites were examined by the Department and its scientific/technical advisors. It was concluded that it is not possible to licence any new aquaculture activity, such as this application, in the Bannow Bay Natura sites as there are no clear mitigation measures available to prevent the risk of deterioration of the conservation status of protected shorebirds. Thus, the licensing of aquaculture activity at these sites would have an adverse effect on the integrity on "Bannow Bay SPA".
