Hi Tina,

Bannow Bay is part of the national shellfish monitoring programmes for both Classification and Biotoxins. It is currently classified as 'B' for both Pacific oysters and mussels with regards to E.coli levels. Biotoxin samples of shellfish are submitted as required depending on harvesting and phytoplankton samples are submitted weekly. Thus, from a general food safety point of view, Bannow Bay is compliant with the relevant legislation for growing oysters and mussels, and provided that the required samples continue to be submitted the food safety risk will be defined. However, it should be noted that a Sanitary Survey is due to be undertaken for Bannow Bay and the results of this could potentially influence classification status.

The location of the production area, and the sites within should have no impact on the control of commercial fisheries.
